

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SOUTH RIVER

BY-LAW NO. 7-85

Being a by-law to Prohibit Overnight Parking on Roads and Road Allowances during the Winter Months.

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to prohibit the parking of vehicles overnight during winter months to facilitate snow control operations:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of South River hereby enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this by-law

(a) "Vehicle" means a motor vehicle or horse drawn vehicle of any kind being drawn, propelled or driven by any power, including muscular power.

(b) "Road" means any part of a road or road allowance normally being used by vehicular traffic.

2. No person shall park a vehicle or otherwise leave a vehicle unattended on any road between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 7:30 a.m. during the period of November 15th to March 31st inclusive.

3. Where a vehicle is found parked or stopped in contravention of the provisions of this by-law; the Public Works Superintendent and/or persons by resolution of the Council of Village of South River, may order the removal of any unlawfully parked vehicle to a suitable place of storage and all costs and charges for the removal, care and storage thereof shall be a lien on such vehicle.

4. Neither the Municipality nor any of its employees or contractors shall be liable for any damages caused to such unlawfully parked vehicles by any equipment engaged in winter maintenance of public roads, or in the removal of said vehicle.
